



Los comentarios racistas del entrenador alemán durante la crono: "¡Atrapa a los camelleros!"

La Federación Alemana ha enviado de vuelta a su país a Patrick Moster, director deportivo del equipo de ciclismo, por sus expresiones racistas durante la contrarreloj del miércoles. "¡Atrapa a los camelleros, atrapa a los camelleros!", gritó desde el coche Moster cuando su corredor, Nikias Arndt, se disponía a alcanzar al eritreo Amanuel Ghebreigzabhier y el argelino Azzedine Lagab. Tras la carrera, Moster hizo públicas sus disculpas: "Lo siento muchísimo, lo menos que puedo hacer es disculparme, no debería haber pasado", declaró el técnico sobre una escena que causó gran revuelo en su país.

"Estamos convencidos que sus disculpas públicas por sus declaraciones racistas son sinceras", declaró el presidente del Comité Olímpico Alemán (DOSB), Alfons Hörmann, "pero con este desliz, Moster violó los valores del olimpismo: para el equipo de Alemania, el fair-play, el respeto y la tolerancia no son negociables".

The German Federation has sent Patrick Moster, the sports director of the cycling team, back to his country for his racist expressions during the time trial on Wednesday. "Catch the camel drivers, catch the camel drivers!" He yelled from the Moster car as his racer, Nikias Arndt, was about to catch up with Eritrean Amanuel Ghebreigzabhier and Algerian Azzedine Lagab. After the race, Moster made his apology public: "I'm very sorry, the least I can do is apologize, it shouldn't have happened," said the coach about a scene that caused a stir in his country.

"We are convinced that his public apologies for his racist statements are sincere," declared the president of the German Olympic Committee (DOSB), Alfons Hörmann, "but with this slip, Moster violated the values of Olympism: for the German team, the fair -play, respect and tolerance are not negotiable. "
