

Choose one of the following scenarios.

Employability:

Last year you completed a work experience placement in Madrid. You have been asked to write about your experience, in **Spanish**, for the language section of your school/college website.

You **must** include the following information, and **should** try to include any other relevant details:

- how you travelled there **and** what you thought of the journey
- where exactly you worked **and** how you got on with your colleagues
- what skills you had to use in your job
- what you did in your free time
- what you did to improve your level of Spanish
- if you would recommend the experience of working abroad to others

You should write approximately 150-180 words.

OR

Society:

You have recently returned from Spain, after spending six weeks staying with a Spanish family. You have been asked to write about your experience, in **Spanish**, by a local travel magazine.

You **must** include the following information, and **should** try to include any other relevant details:

- where exactly the family lived **and** what you thought of the area
- how you helped around the house
- what you did in a normal day
- what trips you went on
- in what was you used your Spanish
- if you would recommend a similar experience to others

You should write approximately 150-180 words.
