### SCENARIO 1: Employability

Last year you completed a work experience placement in Madrid. You have been asked to write about your experience, in **Spanish**, for the language section of your school/college website.

**You must include** the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

You have recently returned from Spain, after spending six weeks staying with a Spanish family. You have been asked to write about your experience, in **Spanish**, by a local travel magazine.

**You must include** the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- Where exactly the family lived **and** what you thought of the area
- How you helped around the house
- What you did in a normal day
- What trips you went on
- In what ways did you use your Spanish
- If you would recommend a similar experience to others

You should write approximately 150-180 words
