SCENARIO 1: Culture

- Where you stayed and what the accommodation was like
- How you got on with your teachers and peers
- What you liked about the French way of life
- What you enjoyed the most/least while in France
- Whether or not you found the experience educational/invaluable

You should write approximately 150-180 words
