Choose one of the following two scenarios.

SCENARIO 1: Employability

Last summer you were given the opportunity to take part in some summer work experience in a German speaking country. Upon your arrival back home in Scotland, you are asked to give an account of your experience in **German**.

You must include the following information and **you should try to** add other relevant details:

- Where you visited to conduct your work experience and where you worked
- What job(s) you carried out while there
- What you liked/disliked about the job
- What your colleagues were like
- What activities you carried out during your free time
- How you plan to remain in touch with your colleagues

You should write approximately 150-180 words.

OR

SCENARIO 2: Society

This year you visited Austria with your family. You have been asked by your schoolteacher to write an account of what took place during your trip in **German**.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- Where you went and how you travelled there
- Where you stayed as a family and what the accommodation was like
- How you got on together
- What you liked about how Austrians live
- What activities you did
- Whether or not you would recommend going to Austria as a holiday destination

You should write approximately 150-180 words.
