Choose one of the following two scenarios.

SCENARIO 1: Culture

Last year, you and your family decided to spend Christmas (or another religious celebration) in France. Upon your arrival back home in Scotland, you are asked to give an account of your experience in **French**.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- Where you visited and how you travelled there
- What activities you took part in while abroad
- What you liked/disliked about the country
- What you thought of Christmas markets in France
- How you celebrated Christmas
- Whether or not you would recommend spending Christmas abroad

You should write approximately 150-180 words.

OR

SCENARIO 2: Learning

In June, you attended a school trip with a big emphasis on learning about French history. When you arrive back in school, your French teacher asks you to write about your experience in **French**.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- Where you went and how you travelled there
- Where you stayed and what the accommodation was like
- How you got on with your teachers and peers
- What you liked about the French way of life
- What you enjoyed the most/least while in France
- Whether or not you found the experience educational

You should write approximately 150-180 words.
