SCENARIO 1: Employability

You should write approximately 150-180 words

SCENARIO 2: Society

Last month, you went to see your friend who was working as a teacher in Spain. You have been asked to write an account of your experience, in Spanish, for your school/college newspaper.

You must include the following information and **you should try to add** other relevant details:

- Where did your friend live **and** what was their accommodation like
- What you did in the evenings
- How did you use your Spanish
- What were the food and weather like
- A day trip you took together
- If you would move to a foreign country **and** why

You should write approximately 150-180 words
